Glaciers (Alaska)

The glaciers lining Alaska's coastline are renowned far and wide — icy behemoths that crawl at a glacial pace across mountain ranges to reach the ocean. The end result is one of nature's best shows: As the glaciers calve, rattling booms are the soundtrack for icebergs plummeting into the water below.



Maya Ruins & Cenotes (Mexican Caribbean)

The Mexican Caribbean is home to two bucket-list experiences. The first is the remnants of the Maya empire — and of the various sites, Chichén Itzá's impressive step pyramid is the star of the show. The second is the cenotes that dot the forest: These naturally formed swimming holes radiate an aura of mystique and enchantment and make for a one-of-a-kind dip.



Machu Picchu (Peru)

The ancient Inca citadel sits cradled in the rugged Andes mountaintops; these cloud-coated remains are the stuff of legend. As one of the few remaining intact Inca ruins, it provides an unparalleled look into the bygone empire.



Galápagos Islands (Ecuador)

The Galápagos are the living embodiment of Darwin's theory of evolution — an expedition across the islands lets you follow in his footsteps to admire a medley of species that seem like funhouse-mirror variations of their cousins on the continent 600 miles away. As stunning as the scenery is, it's the scale of time clearly displayed via evolution that packs the most awe.



Antarctica

The world's southernmost continent is about as close as you can get to a different planet. The vast sheet of frozen landscape is downright alien; even just glimpsing the edges of the continent is an adventure in its own right — especially when that entails sighting the odd whale breach and legions of Adelie penguins while zipping about in a Zodiac.



Geothermal Springs (Iceland)

Iceland is rich with a bounty of geothermal energy and has some of the purest and cleanest water in the world; it was inevitable that the locals would think to combine the two. Geothermal spas and pools dot the island, with the most famous being the Blue Lagoon situated in the center of an old lava field. Letting your worries literally melt away while staring out at the otherworldly scenery is a one-of-a-kind moment.



Marrakech (Morocco)

The red city of Morocco is dotted with historic and gorgeous palaces, verdant gardens, bustling souks, steamy hammams and magnificent mosques, to say nothing of the ultra-modern boutiques, eateries, galleries and hotels. Whether you're window-shopping, people-watching or simply lost in the experience of it all, this is a city with a charm all its own that needs to be experienced at least once in a lifetime.



Monet's Garden (Giverny, France)

The landscapes of Monet are world-renowned; scenic portrayals of serene gardens and water-lilies ponds give a fever-dream feel to create iconic works of art that resonate in the souls of all who view them. Who wouldn't want to wander through the models? Strolling through Monet's garden where he spent his time crafting his masterpieces invites a surreal sense of déjà vu.



Northern Lights (Norway)

On paper, everyone has a passing understanding and appreciation for aurora borealis: Solar wind from the sun collides with the Earth's upper atmosphere, sure sure, it's lights at night. Seeing it in person though? It's 100% a bucket-list moment. The ethereal light show might be the closest you can get to experiencing the awe of space while standing here on Earth. And perhaps no locale is better for viewing the northern lights than Norway's coastline.



Naples (Italy)

There's a lot of bucket-list possibility packed into Naples: it's home to the active volcano of Mount Vesuvius; history buffs will love exploring the Roman ruins of Pompeii and the city's bustling historic center. Foodies will want to make the pilgrimage to the birthplace of modern pizza. Beyond the highlights, it certainly helps that the background of the Gulf of Naples is gorgeous. ▶

Gorilla Trekking (Rwanda)

Hiking through a rainforest-coated mountainside could be bucket-list in and of itself, but hiking through a rainforest-coated mountainside to observe gorillas in their natural habitat at a startlingly close range all things considered? It's the sort of experience that stays with you for life, like a spacewalk or the birth of a child.

African Safari (Kenya & Tanzania)

The African plains, gamelands and savannahs are a one-of-a-kind biome that has been built up in popular culture and collective consciousness since the days of Dr. Livingstone, I presume. A safari through any stretch of these wilds satiates an itch for adventure you might not even realize you had. Lions, giraffes, cheetahs, gazelles and elephants, oh my! Watching the circle of life play out in front of your jeep as a cheetah chases down prey or an elephant chases off a lioness pack will give you goosebumps.

Petra (Jordan)

The once-thriving capital of the ancient Nabataean kingdom makes for an impressive sight — the intricate rock-carved architecture and sophisticated water conduit systems betray the heights of this bygone civilization. Just as impressive is the longevity. John William Burgon said it best: “A rose-red city half as old as time.”

Jeddah (Saudi)

There's a charm to Jeddah that's hard to pin down — until the realization strikes. This city has been the gateway for pilgrimages to Mecca and Medina for millennia, a can't-miss stop on the Incense Route for centuries; a side effect of all that history and prominence is culture begetting culture, like rings on a tree. Historic streets, cool cafes, trendy beach clubs and luxe marinas all play a part in the city's DNA, creating a unique metropolitan escape.

Mumbai (India)

As India's largest city, core financial hub and the heart of the Bollywood film industry, there's a certain liveliness or bustle to the city that few counterparts can match. While it has plenty of marquee sites (The Elephanta Caves, the Gateway of India, Sanjay Gandhi National Park), a trip here is more about the experience than the checklist.

Tokyo (Japan)

There are global cities, and then there's Tokyo. It's hard to put this in context: The greater metropolitan area is home to over 41 million people; roughly the same population of Canada. Tokyo Metropolis is the beating heart of it all — here neon-lit skyscrapers and historic temples are equally at home. Your afternoon might be spent at an arcade or strolling the Imperial Gardens; dinner might be the (in)famous fugu or a baseball-game hotdog.

Kumano Fireworks Festival (Kumano City, Japan)

This 300-year-old Japanese summer tradition is a sight to behold. Every August, the Shichiri Mihama Beach lights up the surrounding region with a two-hour pyrotechnic show as part of the local Obon festivities. The night sky becomes a cacophony of small supernovas; approximately 10,000 fireworks are launched.

Uluru (Northern Territory, Australia)

This towering monolith in the heart of the Australian outback is also the spiritual heartland of ancient Aboriginal culture. It's easy to see why — a certain powerful presence seems to charge the very air as the sunset ignites the 550-million-year-old rock a fiery orange.

Great Barrier Reef (Queensland, Australia)

The world's largest coral reef system is visible from space — even the most novice snorkeler will be overcome with awe swimming among it. Besides the stunning coral formations, other must-see sights include giant clams, rare species of whales and six of the seven marine turtle species ... not to mention the roughly 1,600 species of tropical fish flitting all around you.

Milford Sound (South Island, New Zealand)

Located in Fiordland National Park on New Zealand's South Island, Milford Sound feels like a land that time forgot. This spectacular fiord is wholly untouched by civilization; inky waters flow between towering, mist-clad mountains oozing waterfalls. Ancient rainforests coat the land in a deep, deep shaggy green. Be it a walk, a hike or a kayak expedition, this is one corner of the Earth well worth (proverbially) losing yourself in. ■
